
Pull to fully extend PROfix connector and lock in tabs.




Attach the first plasterboard sheet with the joint midway between joints/trusses.



Mount the PROfix connector to the first sheet at approximately 25mm and 100mm from the butt joint. For added strength, place backblocks between PROfix connector.



Attach the adjoining plasterboard sheet until it butts up with the other. Fix the sheet to PROfix. See Fig 3.



Tape butt joint and fill in flase recess until base and top coat are level with plasterboard.

Does the PROfix system cope with structural frame and truss movement?

The connector will allow movement. The structural design of the bracket will remain a quality connection

Will the PROfix system give an even finish?

The PROfix connector provides an accurate and controlled 1.6mm to 2mm recess, giving an even fill for controlled drying at a constant thickness.

How much does PROfix connector weigh?

At under 600 grams, the PROfix connector is light enough not to cause sagging in the plasterboard.

What are the costs of a PROfix system compared with existing methods?

The initial cost of PROfix connector is offset by time and material savings during installation. Time is saved by eliminating the need to source and shape scrap material. Less filling material and sanding time is required due to controlled, even joints.

Apart from advantages for the plasterer, who else benefits?

The plasterer can complete a quality job in less time, with less effort. The builder minimises the hassle of recalling the plasterer for re-work, delays on downstream contractor and insurance claims.
